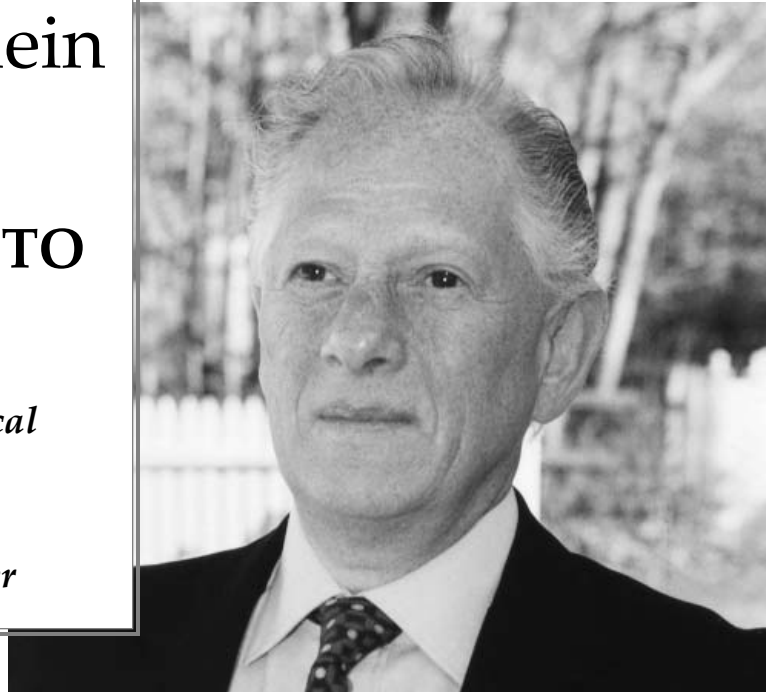

Richard S. Klein, M.D., is a practicing physician in Yorktown Heights, New York, specializing in internal medicine and infectious diseases. He also holds the position of Associate Professor of Medicine at the New York Medical College and serves on the board of the Westchester County (N.Y.) Department of Health.

Dr. Klein has run for Congress in New York's 19th Congressional District, receiving an endorsement from the New York Times for his "immense sense of service and volunteerism to the community at large." He is presently involved with a multitude of volunteer organizations, including his work as board member and physician for My Sisters' Place and the Northern Westchester Shelter, both of which serve battered women and children; and as a volunteer pilot for Angel Flight, an organization that flies cancer patients and their families free of charge to distant treating hospitals.

Dr. Klein has been knighted by the Italian government and received commendations from the Israeli and Egyptian governments in recognition of his efforts on behalf of each of those countries' citizens. A father of two adult daughters, Dr. Klein currently lives with his wife Caryn, his ten-year-old daughter Arianna, and his one and a half-year-old son Matthew in Somers, New York.
